Moving on to the sitting room, you pass through a set of Spanish oak double doors. The client is a follower of Reiki and this practice has played a strong part in this room which is predominately green. Natural looking wall-coverings are made from raw silk. This is an ideal room for entertaining and the sofas and curtains were all designed by Beverley before being manufactured by Moores. Again, hard pelmets have been used at the head of the curtains to create a smooth, perfect finish. Roman blinds, in a co-ordinating stripe, add a smart finish to create a dramatic impact within the bay window. Here, measurements are paramount to creating this stunning yet elegant look.

Beverley explains: "The fireplace is Art-Deco, very contemporary; look around this room and you will see a real mix of traditional and modern influences here."

The family room is functional, decked out with Moores' leather sofas and a natural-looking wall-covering. "This room has an almost clubby feel and is for the family to be able to relax in style," Beverley adds. Originally, part of the kitchen, a wall and glass door have created a partition between this room and the hub of the home.

Upstairs, the master bedroom has been extensively re-designed to create an opulent walk-in wardrobe complemented with his and hers bathrooms. Again, curtains designed and made by Moores Interiors gives this room a luxurious yet extravagant air. Most fabrics used here are silks and have been sourced individually — you

won't see these particular fabrics again on your travels.

"Porcelain tiles and a French cast-iron bath have been used in the bathrooms for the clients to enjoy relaxing and wallowing in pure luxury. The mirror has a filament installed so however hot the room becomes you will not have to endure steaming. The dressing room has been custom-made and furniture was sourced from a firm in Newcastle with drawers for ties, watches and plenty of cupboard space for shoes if you follow in the footsteps of the likes of Imelda Marcos.

Forty people worked on this home and in February 2002, the family moved in with the work complete.
